FAITH GROUPS

- **Bible Studies** are held during Lent and Advent.
- **Sharing Faith and Food** meets on the 1st of the month. People meet for a shared dinner followed by discussion about Christian faith and life.

FELLOWSHIP GROUPS

- **Women's Night Fellowship** meets on the 2nd and 4th Wednesdays of the month at 7.30 p.m. - interesting guest speakers, crafts, dinners and more.
- **Day Fellowship** meets on the 3rd Thursday of each month at 1.30 p.m. where older women enjoy a time of fellowship, devotions, crafts, films, and afternoon tea.
- **The Men's Dinner Group** meets on the 3rd Wednesday of the month at a local restaurant or hotel.

- **Yarn Sisters** meet at the Seacliff Surf Life-Saving Club on the 1st Thursday of the month from 10 am to 12 p.m. to enjoy knitting, crocheting and "yarning" with friendly people over a cup of coffee.

RECREATION GROUPS

- **Cogs 'n Coffee** is held every Wednesday morning. A group of enthusiastic men and women enjoy cycling of various lengths and levels of difficulty. Coffee and chat is a welcome break.
- **Netball.** The Church sponsors twelve netball teams in the summer and winter competitions of the SA Uniting Church Netball Association. The teams train and play at the Kauri Parade Sporting Complex at Seacliff.
